Glinka's Trio Pathétique for Clarinet, Bassoon and Piano in D minor, GIV173, will follow. Its title is misleading, as this is a genial rather than a tragic work. Beethoven's magisterial Quintet for Piano and Winds in Eb major, Op.16, will bring the evening to a triumphant conclusion.

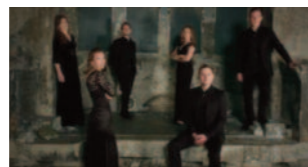

To mark the tenth anniversary of the formation of the consort, ten performers present paired settings of two of the most emotionally charged sacred texts of the Christian tradition. Allegri's wonderful 'Miserere', considered by many to be the most sublime setting of a sacred text, is contrasted with James MacMillan's highly personal response to this prayer in the composer's idiosyncratic and moving style. Palestrina's magisterial double-choir 'Stabat Mater' is heard alongside a fresh response to the emotional depths of this extraordinary text from one of the UK's foremost choral composers, Gabriel Jackson.

Since 1283, when Edward I began work on Conwy Castle, it has been the Parish Church. It contains many features of interest including a Tudor font and a magnificent rood screen of c. 1500. 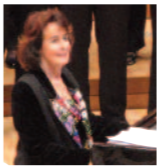

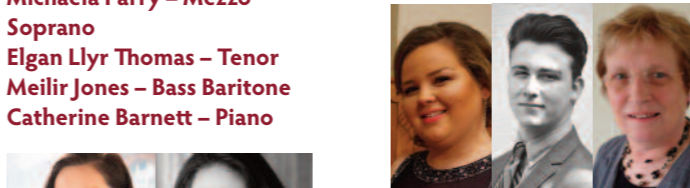

These will be followed by Mozart's Horn Quintet in Eb major, K.407, which is, in effect, a mini horn concerto, and reaches a state of near perfection in the central Andante movement. The evening will culminate in a performance of Mendelssohn's wonderful Octet in Eb major, Op.20, composed when he was only 16, and ever since acclaimed as one of the miracles of 19th century music.
